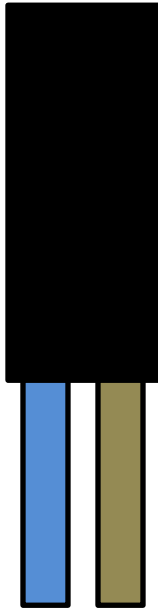
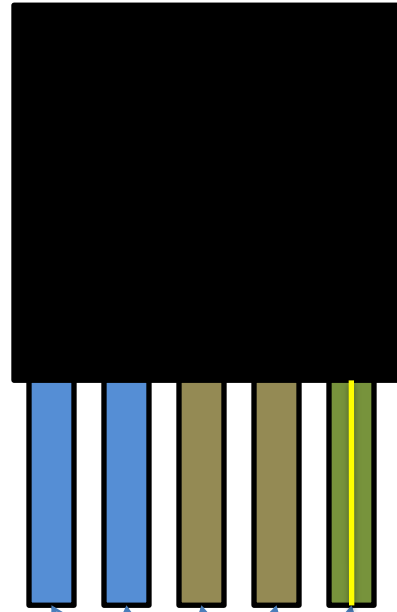


This heater must be wiring in by a competent and qualified electrician

If your hot tub does not have the same plug connection as the new heater we recommend you use a waterproof box and electrical choc block connection. As pictured.

If you do not understand any aspect of this diagram or if the wiring is different please consult the company you purchased from.



New LX Wiring

This cable is no longer needed as the flow switch is integrated into the new heater. Short these two cables together

If the red light on the top of the heater does not turn on, check there is water flow across the heater and there is 240v between live and neutral entering the heater. If there is no water flow or there is no voltage then there is a problem either with the pump or control pack not the heater.
